3. Post-HiN monitoring

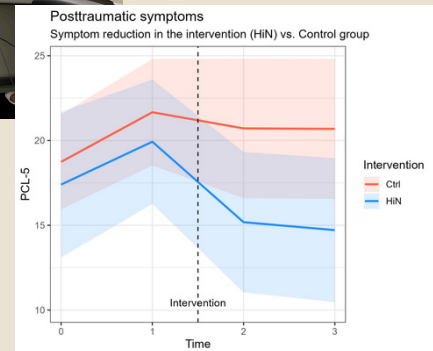
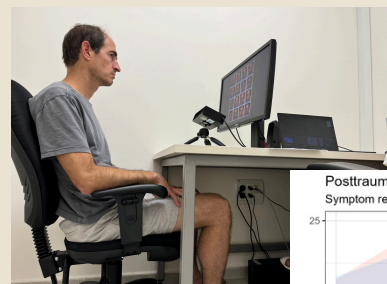
